Are you 15-18 years old and ready to share your artistic talents with the world?

Enter your work in the Golding Showcase: Port Curtis & Callide Valley Youth Art Exhibition and it could be exhibited in Gladstone's professionally-run public art gallery. Your entry will be shown along-side works by other emerging artists and may have the chance to be chosen by the community as the 'face' of next year's Golding Showcase, to be featured on posters to promote the event.

## Just follow three easy steps to enter:

Step One: Fill in both sides of the entry form and attach the label to the back of your work.

**Step Two:** When ready to display, bring it to the Gallery/Museum, corner of Goondoon and Bramston streets, Gladstone between 30 July - 2 August 10am - 5pm.

**Step Three:** Invite your friends and family to the official opening, when exhibition sponsor Mr Cyril Golding will present certificates to exhibiting artists.

The Showcase is a selected exhibition but not a competition. Artists must be 15 -18 years of age on 31 August 2011.

Selected works will, if necessary, be placed in temporary frames prior to display. A catalogue detailing the works, including artist statements will be prepared to accompany the exhibition.

Certificates will be presented to the artists whose work is selected for exhibition. One work will be chosen to be the 'face' of the showcase, and used to promote the 2012 Golding Showcase.

Submissions must be the original work of the participant and created within the 12 months prior to submission.

# **Golding Showcase**

Works in all media and techniques are encouraged such as sculpture, pottery, fibre, painting, collage, printmaking, photography (computer manipulated or digital art), new media etc.

Collaborative works may be included but no more than two works by any one participant are to be submitted.

Complete the entry form, then cut out and attach the small label securely to the back/base of the submitted work.

Artworks may be photographed or reproduced for publicity, archive or catalogue purposes associated with the *Golding Showcase*.

Every care will be taken when handling and exhibiting artworks, but no liability will be accepted for loss or damage.

All entries must be able to be handled safely by two people and preferably ready for display with "D" rings attached, 10cm from the top for larger works & 5cm for smaller works.

The Gallery / Museum has some temporary frames available if required. Please advise prior to submission if a frame is required.

Plinths are available for 3D works, but suitable stands or supports must be included if necessary, for stability.

Works requiring assembly should be accompanied by clear instructions. No work is to be removed during the currency of the exhibition.
