martin hanson



Martin Hanson (1923-76) was MLA for Port Curtis from 1963 until 1976. Hanson was a popular and highly respected local businessman and also patron of the Gladstone Artists Club. As a tribute to Mr Hanson the Club established the Martin Hanson Memorial Art Awards & Exhibition in 1976.

The Artists Club continued to administer the successful and expanding Awards until passing the administration to the Gladstone Regional Art Gallery & Museum in 1993.

From 1976 until her death Mary Hanson (1924-1998) officially opened the exhibition of entries and presented the annual Art Awards in memory of her late husband. The Hansons' daughter, Elizabeth Zussino continues the family commitment to the Awards.

2013 judge



Julie Ewington is a writer, curator and broadcaster. Currently she is Curatorial Manager, Australian Art, at the Queensland Art Gallery | Gallery of Modern Art, leading a department embracing indigenous and non-indigenous art from European colonization to the present. A specialist in Australian contemporary art across all media, she has also written extensively on contemporary art from Southeast

Asia and worked in a curatorial role on the Asia-Pacific Triennial of Contemporary Art series from 1996 to 2012. Previously an art historian in Australian universities, Ewington has worked as a curator since 1989. Her major projects include The Art of Fiona Hall (2005); Scott Redford: Introducing Reinhardt Dammn (2010); and two surveys, Contemporary Australia: Optimism (2008) and Contemporary Australia: Women (2012), all at Queensland Art Gallery.

Her key publications include Brought to Light: Australian Art 1850-1965 and Brought to Light II: Australian Art 1966-2006 (both Queensland Art Gallery, 1998 and 2007, respectively); Fiona Hall (Piper Press, 2005); and Del Kathryn Barton (Piper Press, 2013).

Conditions of Entry

NON-NEGOTIABLE:

1. \$11 entry fee (inc. GST) per artwork. Non-refundable. Artists must be 15 years or over. Up to two (2) works per artist may be submitted.
2. A collaborative work is seen as an entry by each individual collaborator.
3. Entry fee, completed entry form and labelled artwork to be received by 5pm Saturday 2 November 2013 for assessment by the preview panel. Late entries will not be accepted.
4. All works will be viewed by the Judge, but only those selected by the preview panel and judge will be exhibited. Judge's decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.

ELIGIBILITY:

5. All works and concepts must be the original, unaided work of the entrant and created during the twelve months prior to 30 October 2013.
6. Works not to exceed **1.65 metres x 1.65 metres**, inclusive of frame/mount etc.
7. All entries are eligible for the **Rio Tinto Alcan Martin Hanson Memorial Art Award**. In addition, an artwork may be entered into a section award and also be eligible for the **Local Artist, Youth Artist and Murri Artist Awards**.
8. **Murri Artist Award:** The entrant must identify as an Aboriginal, Torres Strait or South Sea Islander artist and be a resident of at least three months duration within the boundaries of Gladstone Regional, North Burnett Regional and Banana Shire Councils.
9. **Wide Bay Australia Ltd. Local Artist Award:** The entrant must be a resident of at least three months duration within the boundaries of the Gladstone Regional, North Burnett Regional and Banana Shire Councils.
10. **Not Eligible:** Workshop projects, commercially produced kits, designs, etc, or works that have already previously won a major award.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS:

11. Works not for sale must be clearly marked **NFS**.
12. Entries with multiple components are considered one work and must include clear assembly instructions and a photo or sketch of how entry is to look when displayed.
13. Works should be safely handled by up to two people.
14. Works to be hung must be submitted with "D" attachments. 10cm from top of frame for larger works, 5cm for smaller works. Plinths are available for 3D works, however stands or supports must be included where necessary.

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION:

15. Arrangements and expenses pertaining to the delivery and collection of entries to the Gallery/Museum are the entrant's responsibility. Return freight must be prepaid. Consignment notes, pre-paid vouchers or postage stamps etc, to be enclosed with entry form.

16. Works must be delivered to the Gallery/Museum between 10am and 5pm, 30 October - 2 November 2013 and collected between 6 - 9 December 2013. No responsibility will be taken for unclaimed entries. Entries not collected by the due date will be sent to auction.

UPON ENTERING A SUBMISSION, I UNDERSTAND:

17. The Gallery/Museum reserves the right to reproduce entries for publicity (print and online), catalogue and archival purposes in association with the Awards.
18. The Gallery/Museum takes care in exhibiting and handling entries, however works are submitted at the entrants risk. No liability will be accepted for any loss or damage; either in transit or while on display.
19. No works are to be removed or photographed during the exhibition's duration.
20. A commission of 20% (+10% GST on commission) will be taken on all works sold.
21. Gladstone Regional Art Gallery & Museum will have first option to purchase works for the permanent collection.
22. All entrants are invited to attend the exhibition's opening events on Saturday 9 November 2013. RSVP to the Gallery/Museum by 5pm Wednesday 6 November 2013.
