MARTIN HANSON



Martin Hanson (1923 - 1976) was Member for Legislative Assembly (MLA) for Port Curtis from 1963 until 1976. Hanson was a popular and highly respected local businessman and also patron of the Gladstone Artists Club. As a tribute to Mr Hanson the Club established the Martin Hanson Memorial Art Awards & Exhibition in 1976.

The Artists Club continued to administer the successful and expanding Art Awards until passing the administration to the Gladstone Regional Art Gallery & Museum in 1993.

From 1976 until her death Mary Hanson (1924-1998) officially opened the exhibition of entries and presented the Art Awards in memory of her late husband. To this day, the Hansons' daughter, Elizabeth Zussino still continues her family's commitment by sponsoring the Murri Artist Award.

NON-NEGOTIABLE:

- 1. \$15 entry fee (incl. GST) per artwork, non-refundable.
- 2. Artists must be 15 years or over at time of entry.
- Up to two works per artist may be submitted only. A collaborative work is seen as an entry by each individual collaborator.
- Entry fee, completed entry form and labelled artwork/s to be received by 5pm, Saturday 1 November 2014 for assessment by the preview panel. Late entries will not be accepted.
- All works will be viewed by the Judge, but only those selected by the preview panel and Judge will be exhibited. Judge's decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.

ELIGIBILITY:

\$1,500

- All works and concepts must be the original, unaided work of the entrant and created during the twelve months prior to 30 October 2014.
- 7. Works cannot exceed 1.65 metres in any direction.
- 8. All entries are eligible for the Rio Tinto Alcan Martin Hanson Memorial Art Award. In addition, an artwork may be entered into a section Award and also be eligible for the South Gladstone Rotary Club / Multitrade Youth Emergent Artist Award, Murri Artist Award sponsored by Elizabeth & Leo Zussino, Yaralla Sports Club Local Artist Award and QAL People's Choice Award for registered section.
- South Gladstone Rotary Club / Multitrade Youth Emergent Artist Award: The entrant must be a resident of Queensland and be aged between 15 to 25 years (by 30 October 2014).
- 10. Murri Artist Award sponsored by Elizabeth & Leo Zussino: The entrant must identify as an Aboriginal, Torres Strait or South Sea Islander artist and be a resident within the boundaries of Gladstone Regional, North Burnett Regional or Banana Shire Councils, for at least 3 of the 12 months prior to 30 October 2014.

- 13. QAL People's Choice Awards: All entrants are eligible to win in their registered section, as voted by the general public while visiting the exhibition. One prize will be awarded to each section. Votes collected at the Gallery & Museum voting kiosks only. - NOT eligible: Workshop projects, commercially produced kits, designs, etc, works that have previously won a major award or works that were completed over 12 months ago.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS:

- 15. Works not for sale must be clearly marked NFS.
- Entries with multiple components are considered one work and must include clear assembly instructions with a photo or sketch of how entry is to look when displayed.
- 17. Works should be safely handled by up to two people.
- 18. Works to be hung must be submitted with "D" attachments, 10cm from top of frame for larger works, 5cm for smaller works. Plinths are available for 3 dimensional works however, stands or supports must be provided by the artist where necessary.

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION:

- 19. Arrangements and expenses pertaining to the delivery and collection of entries to the Gallery & Museum are the entrant's responsibility. Return freight must be prepaid. - 24. A commission of 20% (+ GST on commission) will be taken on all works sold.
- 25. Gladstone Regional Art Gallery & Museum will have first option to purchase works for the permanent collection.
