### INTRO

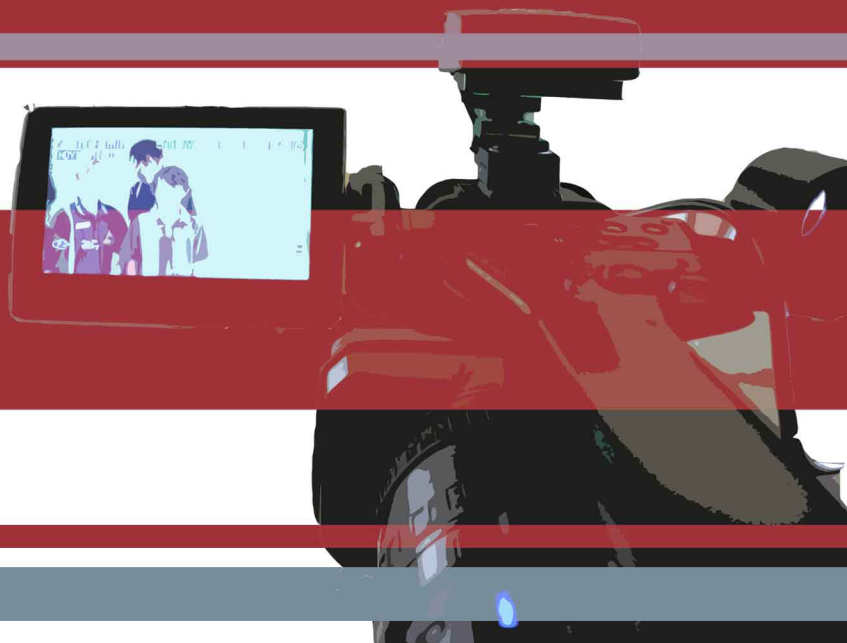
Are you interested in creating a short film? If you are, In The Bin's Educational Film Workshop is the program for you. In The Bin has been travelling Australia for the past eight years producing workshops for budding filmmakers from age 14 up. In The Bin provides you with all the equipment and education need to produce the short films, including four HD cameras, and four Avid editing systems (all industry standard). You don't even need previous knowledge on film, all you need is an interest. So come on join In The Bin at one of your surrounding locations for a three day experience you won't regret.

### DAY1

During this day students will be prepped on pre-production. This includes: watching and analysing both professional and students short films, developing your storyline, learning camera techniques to enhance your film, reviewing tutorials, and much more. In The Bin has the capacity to accommodate up to 30 students each workshop you will be broken up into four groups. In these groups you will start to develop a story. From there you decide where you'd like to film and what shots you'd like to achieve. The workshop instructors will be with you every step of the way to make you feel comfortable. When the day comes to an end you will have a storyboard completed, a shot list finalized, and characters set. Don't forget to bring props and costumes for the next day!

### DAY2

During Day 2 you will truly feel like a director. After getting prepped on the film equipment, you and your group will get to travel to the location of your choice to capture your scenes. Today you get to call the shots. Choose how to angle scenes and place actors or even be the one on screen. In The Bin workshop instructors will visit the groups throughout the day to make sure everything is going well. Once you've experienced the life of a film director, you'll meet back at the workshop location to turn in your camera and upload your film.





## DAY3

Having learnt how to film, today you will make your film. Students will work on their own computer fully equipped with state of the art editing software that will take your film from good to great. If you're not computer savvy, don't be intimidated. This program is very easy to learn, and like before the In The Bin instructors will be there to help you all day long. Cutting your scenes to flow together from overlaying different noises and effects will re-establish why film is so intriguing. Now you're excited because you've completed your short film, but here comes the best part. It's debuting in a film festival later that evening!

## Festival

The night will be buzzing with excitement when you arrive to the festival. Take your seat with your family and friends and get ready to experience a night that will make you feel accomplished. In The Bin will start the festival off with a handful of professional films, and then launch into the newly produced workshop films. Without question, your film will get a great reaction. The audience will undoubtedly be impressed with the piece
