The Showcase is a selected exhibition of works, not a competition; Artists must be 15 -18 years of age; Submissions must be the original work of the participant and created within the 12 months prior to submission; Collaborative works may be included but no more than two works by any one participant are to be submitted; No size limits; Works in all media and techniques are encouraged, including computer manipulated or digital art; Artworks may be photographed or reproduced for publicity, archive or catalogue purposes associated with the *Golding Showcase*; Every care will be taken when handling and exhibiting artworks, but no liability will be accepted for loss or damage; All entries must be able to be handled safely by two people and ready for display with 'D' rings attached, 10cm from the top for larger works and 5cm for smaller works.
