2. Submissions close 4pm, Friday, 20 December 2019 and can be delivered to: Gladstone Regional Art Gallery & Museum, cnr Goondoon & Bramston Streets, Gladstone or posted to: PO Box 29, Gladstone QLD 4680.
3. Winners will be announced Sunday, 26 January 2020, during Gladstone Regional Council’s Australia Day celebrations at Gladstone Tondoon Botanic Gardens.
4. In 2020, entries will be displayed in the Gladstone Tondoon Botanic Gardens Visitors Centre Gallery during January, the Mezzanine Floor, Leo Zussino Building CQUniversity Gladstone Marina Campus during February, the Gallery & Museum March to April, Boyne Tannum Community Centre May to June, Gladstone City Library June to July and Calliope Library August to September. Digitised exhibitions of entries will also be displayed at selected Council venues throughout the year.
5. Fourteen selected artworks will be sent to Saiki City, Japan in conjunction with Japanese Children’s Day events during June 2021.
6. Fourteen prize winning entries will be printed as Council’s 2020 Australia Day commemorative postcards
