4. Winners will be announced Tuesday, 26 January 2021, during Gladstone Regional Council’s Australia Day celebrations.

In 2021, entries will be displayed at the Mezzanine Floor, Leo Zussino Building CQUniversity Gladstone Marina Campus January to February, the Gallery & Museum March to April, Boyne Tannum Community Centre May to June, Gladstone City Library June to July and Calliope Library August to September. Digitised exhibitions of entries will also be displayed at selected Council venues throughout the year. (Tour dates and venues are subject to change)
6. Fourteen selected artworks will be sent to Saiki City, Japan in conjunction with Japanese Children’s Day events during October 2021.
7. Fourteen prize winning entries will be printed as Council’s 2021 Australia Day commemorative postcards
