Since then his artworks have been curated in local and international exhibitions and are held in institutional collections in both Australia and abroad.

JANICE KUCZKOWSKI was born in Brisbane before moving to live and work in Canberra. A visual artist, curator, and arts-manager, she holds a Bachelor of Fine Art from Queensland College of Art. Her work has been screened and exhibited both nationally and internationally, as well as produced as public video art commissions in QLD and ATC.
