



Reflections of Yesteryear

A fine art exhibition by Marie Green

Using the traditional medium of oil on canvas, Green examines the everyday lives of Queenslanders living and working in tough conditions between 1880 and 1980. In particular focusing on the 'normal' activities that ordinary Queenslanders did once, but no longer do now. The exhibition also includes a digital component with photographs and oral histories relaying first person anecdotes and stories behind a number of the paintings on display.
