The Queensland network includes in excess of 6,000 regional members. Through this network, and partnerships with other Queensland leading performing arts companies, a broad and dynamic range of performances, exhibitions, workshops, master classes, arts-related services and funding programs are offered to Queensland communities.

Artslink Queensland is supported by the State and Federal Governments, as well as working closely with local Council's to play a national advocacy role for regional arts as this state's member of the National body, Regional Arts Australia.

Artslink Queensland operates core programs that provide arts access state-wide and reach a wide audience of Queenslanders, annually.

Artslink Queensland's **Exhibition Program** brings the artworks of Queensland's regional artists to communities across the state. In 2013, featured exhibitions include photography, painting, textiles, sculpture, drawing, installation and printmaking.
