Admission tickets will be issued on the spot when the booking is confirmed. The indemnity form must still be completed and copies will be available at the Gladstone Entertainment Centre Box Office.

OR

3. Phone the Bookings Hotline with your list of activities and pay by credit card. Admission tickets will be available for pick up from the Entertainment Centre's Box Office, along with the indemnity form for completion.
