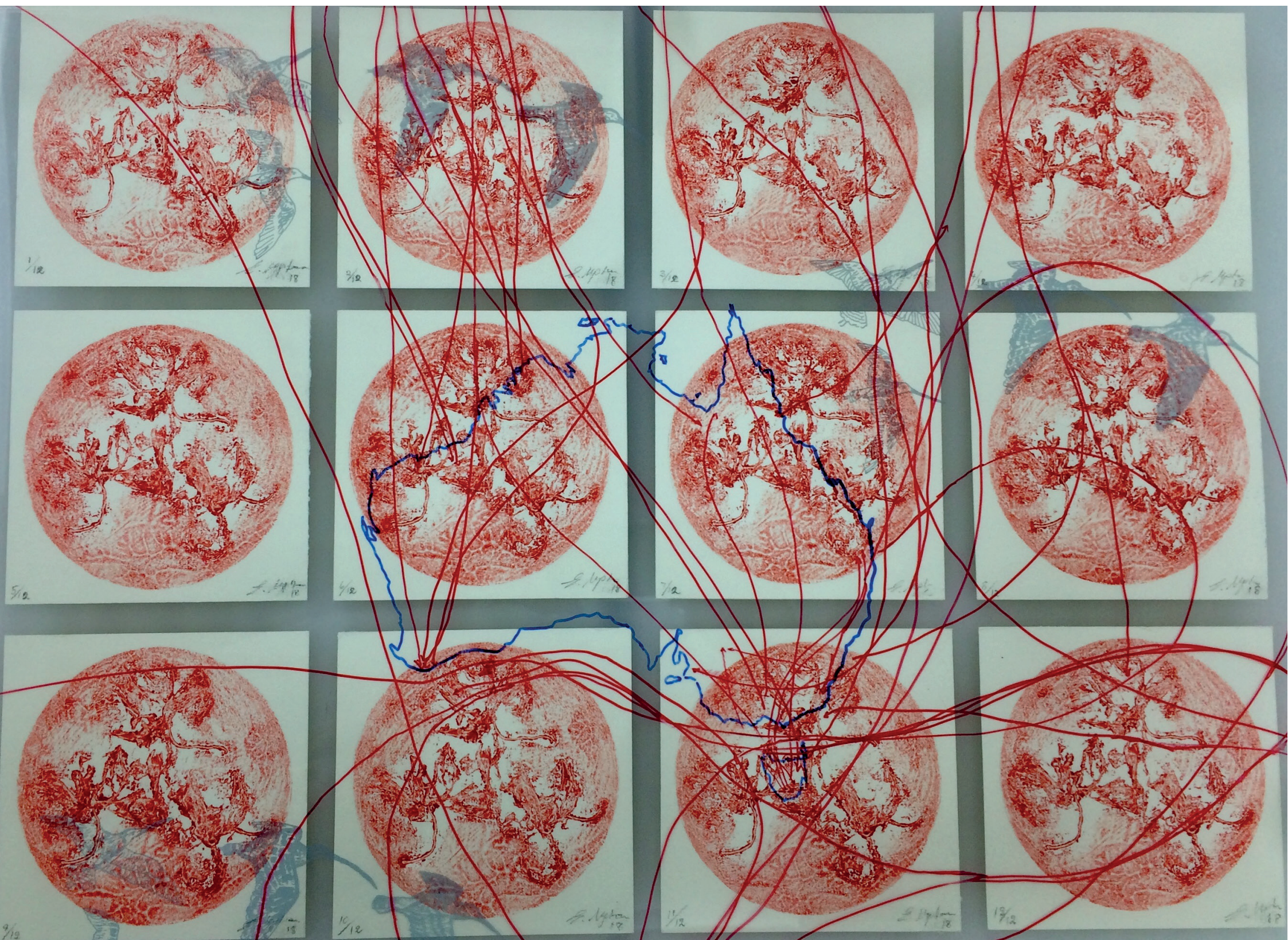


Wetlanders

Wetlanders is an exhibition of prints, artists' books and drawings about the wetlands of Moreton Bay and the migratory shore birds that overwinter in the region every year.
