

## ALDOUS, David Black

Enlisted at Rockhampton on 16 September 1915, age 25 years 4 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Mary Aldous (nee Black), Calliope, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 6 inches and weighed 10 stone 0 lbs. His chest measurement was 36 inches. His occupation was stockman. He served in France and was wounded in action on 18 November 1916 and again on 10 June 1918. He transferred to 26<sup>th</sup> Battalion on 22 September 1918 and returned to Australia on 27 April 1919. David Black Aldous died on 16 September 1956.
