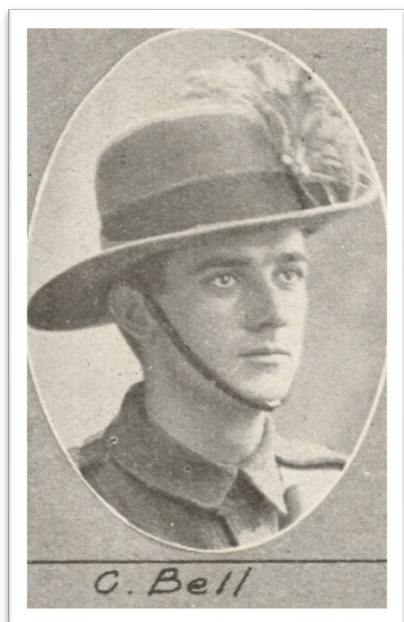


BELL, Campbell

Date of Birth: 20 October 1893

Enlisted at Rockhampton 6 July 1915 age 21 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was his father, Mr Robert Bell, "Verona", Cavendish Road, Coorparoo, Brisbane, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 9 inches and weighed 146 lbs. His chest measurement was 35.5-36.5 inches. His occupation was grazier. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board HMAT A47 *Mashobra* on 4 October 1915. While serving in France he suffered a fractured left clavicle in a football accident. After serving in France he returned to Australia via America at his own expense on 12 April 1919, and discharged from service.
