

## **BIGG, Stanley (Biggs on Honour Roll)**

Rank: Private

Service Number: 276A

Unit: 3/12 Machine Gun Company

Place of Birth: Bexley Heath, Kent, England

Date of Birth: c June 1890 (June Quarter 1890, England)

Enlisted at Rockhampton on 8 February 1916 at age 25 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was firstly his brother, Roland Murray Bigg, Boolaroo, NSW. On enlistment he was 5 feet 7 inches and weighed 11 stone 0 lbs. His chest measurement was 38 inches. His occupation was selector. He married Katie Wright on 28 September 1917 in the Parish Church of St Anne in Middlesex, England. While serving in France, he was wounded in action on 18 May 1918 with a gunshot wound to the right leg. He returned to Australia on and discharged from service on 30 May 1920. Stanley died on 25 December 1949.
