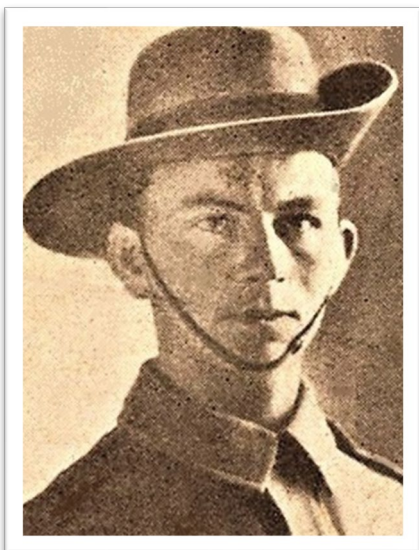


## BULL, Harold Joyce

Date of Birth: 4 May 1895

Enlisted at Rockhampton on 3 February 1915 age 19 years 9 months. Next-of-kin was his father Thomas Bull, 4 Cheriton Road, Folkestone, Kent, England. On enlistment he was 5 ft 7¾ inches and weighed 134 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-35 inches. His occupation was farm labourer, Littlemore. He served in Gallipoli and France, and received a Distinguished Conduct Medal. "For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty. When acting as medical orderly, he, on his own initiative, moved forward during the action, to the front line. He carried medical stores through heavy artillery fire, where he attended in the open trench under severe conditions."

He was Killed in Action on 25 August 1918, aged 23 years, and is buried at Heath Cemetery, Picardie, France. A Memorial Plaque and Memorial Scroll were sent to Harold's parents in England in 1922.
