

## **CAMBRIDGE, William**

Place of Birth: Huddersfield, Yorkshire, England

Date of Birth: Unknown. Stated aged 24y3m in 1915. (1892) Later on marriage 1916, stated aged 31 y. (1885) Not found on General Register Office index.

Enlisted at Gladstone 8 March 1915 age 24 yrs 3 months. Next-of-kin was C White, Healy and Cran, Bundaberg, Queensland, and later his wife, Gertrude Millicent CAMBRIDGE, whom he married in England. On enlistment he weighed 132 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-37 inches. His occupation was G L - (General Labourer). While serving in Mudros, he contracted dysentery and was dangerously ill for some time. After serving in France returned to Australia on 20 October 1918 and discharged from service on 3 March 1919.
