Enlisted at Rockhampton 29 January 1916 age 21 years 3 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Annie Campbell, Boolboonda, Mt Perry Line, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 6.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 6 lbs. His chest measurement was 35.5 inches. His occupation was miner. He served in France and was reported missing on 11 April, 1917. He was captured as a prisoner of war captured at Reincourt and interned at Limburg, Germany. He was repatriated and arrived in England on 15 December 1918. He returned to Australia on 2 August 1918 and discharged from service on 16 November 1919.
