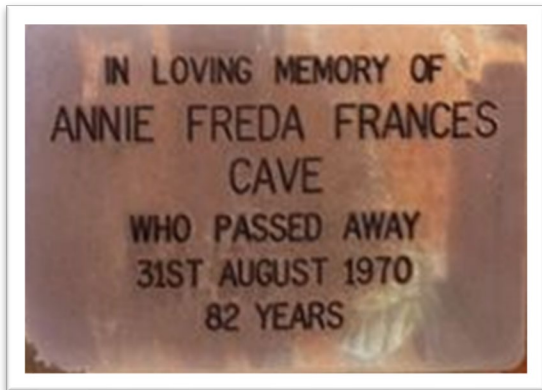

Aged 29 years 0 months. On 21 March 1917, Staff Nurse Cave embarked overseas on HMAT Kanowna A61. Her next-of-kin was her mother, Mrs Daymar (sic. Dagmar) Samuella Cave, "Galloway Plains" station, via Calliope, Queensland. SN Cave served in Alexandria and Egypt. She returned to Australia on HMAT Kanowna on 22 July 1918 with medical disability of Enteritis.
