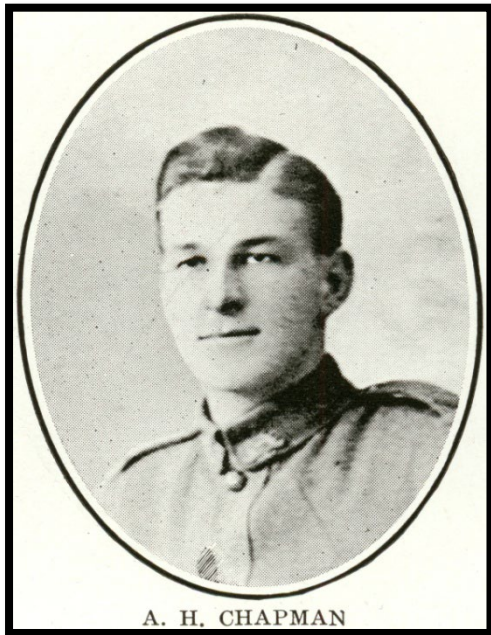


## CHAPMAN, Albert Humphrey

Date of Birth: 14 October 1897

Enlisted at Enoggera, Qld 13 June 1916 age 18 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Sarah Ann Chapman (nee Duckham), Barmundoo, near Gladstone, Queensland. Personal measurements are not recorded on his service record. His occupation was stockman. He served in France and was wounded in action, gunshot wound to the face, 19 August 1918 and was invalided to UK on 22 August 1918. He returned to Australia 11 June 1919.
