

Enlisted at Gladstone 1 March 1915 age 19 years 7 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs S Crampton, Bracewell, Mt Larcom, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 7.5 inches and weighed 130 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-34.5inches. His occupation was apprentice cordial maker to C Crampton. He was a member of Gladstone Rifle Club. He served at Gallipoli. While serving there, he was admitted to hospital with appendicitis, operation 29 September 1915. He then returned to Egypt to serve, and later served in France. Before returning to Australia he was married in England to Mary Jane Jackson.

He returned to Australia on 9 July 1919 and discharged 9 November 1919.
