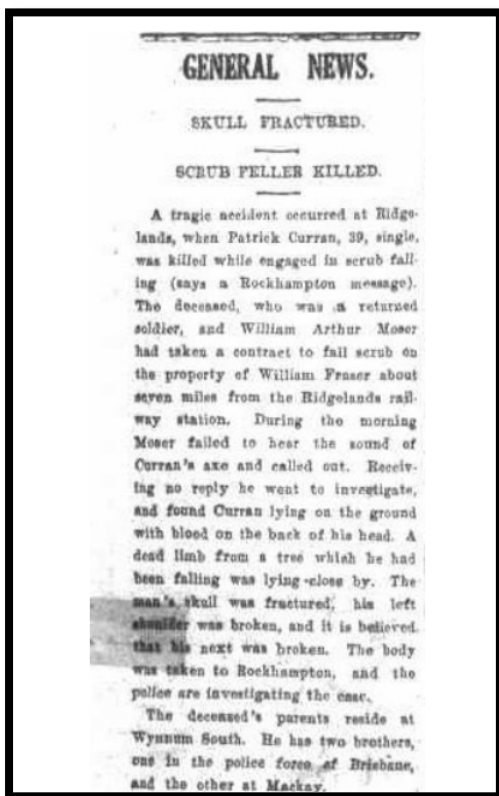

Date of Birth: 12 September 1892

Enlisted at Rockhampton 19 January 1916 age 23 years 6 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Bridget Curran, "Glen Vale", Yarwun, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 7 inches and weighed 10 stone 6 lbs. His chest measurement was 38 inches. His occupation was labourer. He served in France and was wounded in action in France on 30 March 1918 and again in 1919 in England with a shell wound to his upper arm (compound fracture). He returned to Australia on 15 September 1918 and discharged from service on 6 December 1918.

In 1932 Curran was accidentally killed while felling trees.
