Enlisted at Rockhampton 5 February 1916 age 29 years 10 months. Next-of-kin was his wife, Mrs Annie Duncan, Pinnacle Hotel, Pinnacle, via Walkerstone, Mackay, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 11 inches and weighed 14 stone 7 lbs. His chest measurement was 40 inches. His occupation was butcher. Duncan proceeded overseas on 21 November 1916 to France and was admitted to hospital sick with mumps in January 1917. He served in France at Boulogne, Calais and Etaples. Admitted to hospital with influenza on 14 February 1919 and died of disease on 16 February 1919.

He was buried in Baraques Military Cemetery: Les Baraques Military Cemetery (Plot VIII, Row D, Grave No. 4A0, Sangatte, France.
