Enlisted at Rockhampton 29 March 1916 age 23 years 2 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Margaret Fisher, West End, Gladstone, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 8.5 inches and weighed 142 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-35.5 inches. His occupation was Night Officer. Fisher embarked on 16 August 1916 for France.

He received an accidental contusion to his shoulder and was admitted to hospital 2 October 1917. Fisher returned to France and was killed in action on 11 August 1918, and is buried at Cote 80 French National Cemetery, Etinehem, Somme, France, Row D, 14. His headstone bears the inscription "Just one of our young men who came forward and served willingly."
