

FLANAGAN, John Henry

Date of Birth: c.1875.

Enlisted at Rockhampton, Qld, on 26 August 1915, age 37 years 11 months. Next-of-kin was his father, James Flanagan, Manchester, Lancashire, England. On enlistment he was 5 feet 5.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 0 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-37.25 inches. His occupation was labourer. He served in North Africa. Sustained an accidental injury to his left foot on 25 March 1918 when he fell from a wagon and a wheel passed over his foot. Admitted to hospital with contusions. Discharged from hospital 17 April 1918. Convalescent to 24 April 1918.

Discharged 27 September 1919.
