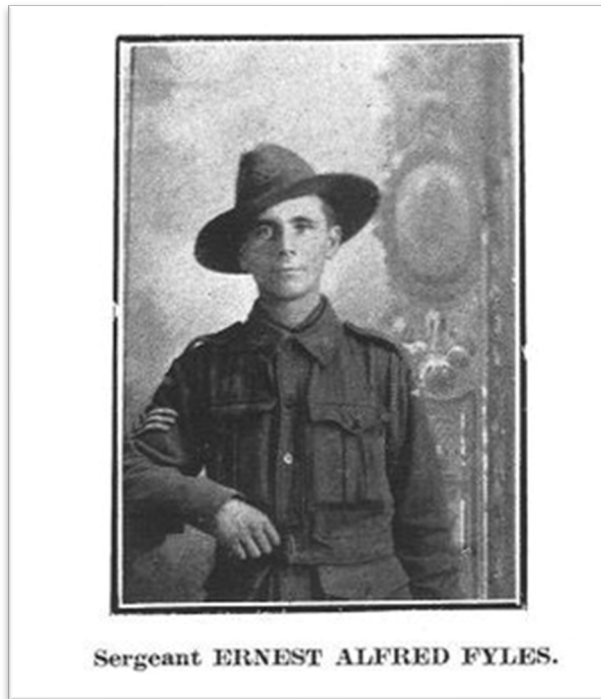


## FYLES, Ernest Alfred

Date of Birth: 2 March 1889/1890.

Enlisted at Rockhampton, Qld on 23 November 1915 age 25 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Elizabeth Fyles, 7 Stanley Street, Clapham, London, England. On enlistment he was 5 feet 6 inches and weighed 9 stone 6 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-36 inches. His occupation was timber cutter. He served in France. He was promoted to Sergeant on 31 March 1917 and returned to Australia on 2 June 1919 where he was discharged 8 September 1919. Awarded Military Medal 8 September 1918.

Ernest Alfred Fyles also enlisted in WW2, Lieutenant Q212925 13<sup>th</sup> Battalion Volunteer Defence Corps. He stated on this file that he lived at Bracewell, Mount Larcom, Queensland and his occupation was dairy farmer. Next-of-kin was his wife, Mrs Guenevere Marion Fyles, Bracewell, Mt Larcom, Qld.
