
FYLES, Ernest Alfred

Date of Birth: 2 March 1889/1890.

Enlisted at Rockhampton, Qld on 23 November 1915 age 25 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Elizabeth Fyles, 7 Stanley Street, Clapham, London, England. On enlistment he was 5 feet 6 inches and weighed 9 stone 6 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-36 inches. His occupation was timber cutter. He served in France. He was promoted to Sergeant on 31 March 1917 and returned to Australia on 2 June 1919 where he was discharged 8 September 1919. Awarded Military Medal 8 September 1918.

Ernest Alfred Fyles also enlisted in WW2, Lieutenant Q212925 13th Battalion Volunteer Defence Corps. He stated on this file that he lived at Bracewell, Mount Larcom, Queensland and his occupation was dairy farmer. Next-of-kin was his wife, Mrs Guenevere Marion Fyles, Bracewell, Mt Larcom, Qld.
