

Enlisted at Gladstone, Queensland age 30 years 5 months.

Next-of-kin was Mrs Geissmann, 'Capo di Monte', Mt Tambourine, Qld. On enlistment he was 5 feet 10.5 inches and weighed 165 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-36.5 inches. His occupation was stockman. Geissmann served in Gallipoli and North Africa. He suffered from illness (mumps) and contusion of the spine and returned to Australia on 21 February 1917. Discharge 18 April 1917.
