
## **GILCHRIST, Henry Edward**

Enlisted at Rockhampton 1 October 1915 age 21 years 6 months. Next-of-kin was his father, Edward Gilchrist, Netherby, North Coast Line, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 5.5 inches. His chest measurement was 36.25 inches. His occupation was schoolteacher. He had been a member of Cadets for 6 months. He served on the Western Front. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A73 *Commonwealth* on 28 March 1916. Promoted to Corporal 1 September 1917. Promoted temporary Sergeant when Fraser deceased 19 November 1917. Promoted sergeant France 23 April 1918.

Returned to Australia 8 September 1919.
