

GOLDEN, Patrick Joseph

Enlisted at Brisbane on 29 January 1916, aged 30 years 1 month.

Next-of-kin was his mother, Mary Ann Golden, Dublin, Ireland.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 8 inches and weighed 8 stone 7 lbs. His chest measurement was 34 - 37 inches. His occupation was seaman. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A49 *Seang Choon* on 4 May 1916. Served in Egypt. Found guilty of various charges throughout his career. Commenced return to Australia from Port Said on board HT *Plassy*, 20 September 1919; disembarked Sydney, 30 October 1919; discharged, Brisbane, 25 November 1919.
