

## **GRANT, Andrew Livingstone Learmonth (Learmouth in some records)**

Enlisted at: Rockhampton, Qld, on 29 July 1915, aged 20 years 7 months

Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs Clara Elizabeth Grant, Yarroon Street, Gladstone, Qld. Later East Vulture Street, South Brisbane, Queensland

On enlistment he was 5 ft 5.5 inches and weighed 8 stone 4 lbs. His chest measurement was 32-34 inches. His occupation was clerk. Prior to enlistment, he had two years in Port Curtis Infantry Reg. Embarked from Sydney on 20 December 1915 on *HMAT Suevic* A29. Served Egypt 24 January 1916. Admitted hospital 30 March 1916 Ismalia. Rejoined unit 14 April 1916. Confirmed corporal Tel el Fara 26 April 1917. Warrant Officer February 1919. Returned to Australia 29 April 1919. Died 27 May 1969.
