Enlisted at Rockhampton, Queensland, on 6 May 1916 aged 26 years 1 month.

Next-of-kin was wife Mary Kathleen Gregg, c/- Mrs Brady, Park View Street, Milton's Height, Brisbane, Queensland.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 10 inches and weighed 10 stone 10 lbs. His chest measurement was 40 inches. His occupation was farmer, Mount Larcom, Queensland. On arrival in England he was diagnosed with synovitis. He did not receive the Victory Medal as he had not served in a Theatre of War. Received British War Medal. Returned to Australia 9 December 1918. Died 7 December 1977.
