Enlisted at Gladstone, on 3 April 1916 aged 24 years 6 months.

Next-of-kin was his mother, Margaret Ann Harvey (nee Fisher), Mt Larcom

On enlistment he was 5 feet 7.5 inches and weighed 9 stone 7 lbs. His chest measurement was 35 inches. His occupation was fireman. Died of disease, measles and pneumonia, No. 4 Infectious Diseases Hospital, "Rosemount", Brisbane 30 May 1916. Buried Toowong Cemetery, Brisbane, Queensland.
