Unit: 11<sup>th</sup> Light Horse Regiment, 4<sup>th</sup> Reinforcement

Place of Birth: Riverston, near Gladstone, Queensland.

Date of Birth: 21 December 1888 (Linnet Sinclair HICKSON)

Enlisted at Gladstone, Queensland, on 29 June 1915 aged 26 years 6 month.

Next-of-kin was father George Hickson, Goondoon Street, Gladstone, Qld and mother, Mrs MJ Hickson. On enlistment he was 5 feet 8.5 inches and weighed 163 lbs. His chest measurement was 37/39 inches. His occupation was grazier.

Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT

A1 *Hymettus* on 17 September 1915. Served in Egypt. Returned to Australia 16 May 1919.

Medals: 1914/15 Star; British War Medal; Victory Medal.
