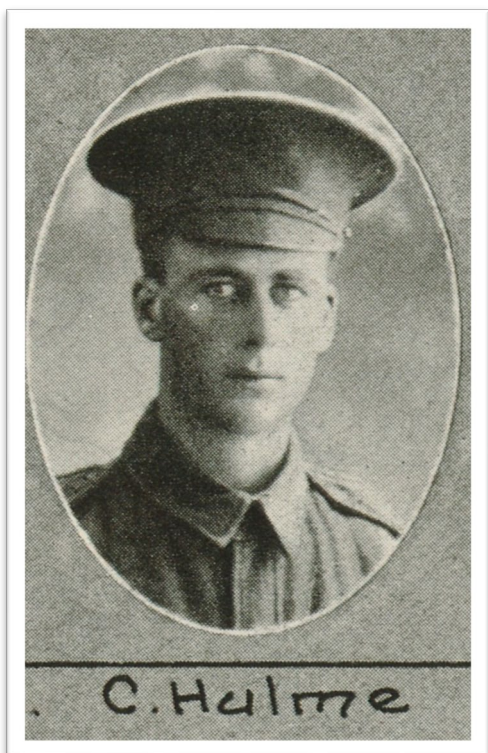


## HULME, Charlie (Charles/Charley) (Hulm on Honour Roll)

Unit: 25<sup>th</sup> Battalion, 10<sup>th</sup> Reinforcement

Place of Birth: Calliope, Queensland

Date of Birth: 18 June 1891

Enlisted at Gladstone, Queensland, on 31 August 1915, aged 24 years 3 months. Next-of-kin was father Richard Hulme, Calliope, Queensland. On enlistment he was 5 feet 10.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 4 lbs. His chest measurement was 36 inches. His occupation was labourer. Served in Egypt, France, and Belgium. Wounded in action 6 March 1917, GSW left knee. Rejoined battalion 27 August 1917. Killed in action 4 October 1917. Buried the following day at Frost House, Sheet 28 Square D.26a 62, Chaplain BD Wilson officiating. Commemorated Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Flanders, Belgium.
