


## IRONMONGER, Thomas (believed to be S Ironmonger)

Date of Birth: 18 March 1894

Enlisted at Rockhampton, on 11 October 1916 after recruiting in Gladstone on 11 October 1916, aged 22 years 7 months. Next-of-kin was his mother, Mrs Ann Low Ironmonger. Enlisted on same date as his brother Robert George Ironmonger. On enlistment he was 6 feet 1 inch and weighed 164 lbs. His chest measurement was 36/38.2 inches. His occupation was labourer. Served in France in the same unit as his brother at first. Admitted hospital with influenza on 30 November 1918. Returned to Australia 23 July 1919 disembarking on 10 September 1919.
