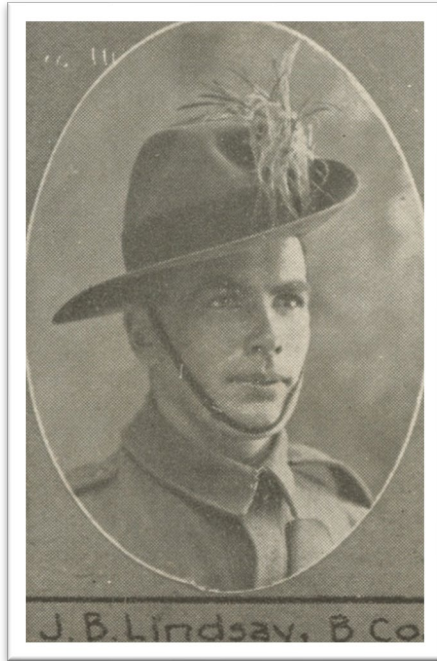


## LINDSAY, James Bruce

Unit: 5<sup>th</sup> Light Horse Regiment/4<sup>th</sup> Signal Troop Australian Engineers

Place of Birth: Dalsersf, Larkhall, Lanarkshire, Scotland

Date of Birth: c. November 1888.

Enlisted at Gladstone, on 24 October, 1914, aged 25 years 11 months.

Next-of-kin was his sister, Mrs Steel, Briarbank, Larkhall, Scotland.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 8 inches and weighed 158 lbs. His chest measurement was 38.5 inches. His occupation was stone cutter. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board Transport A34 *Persic* on 21 December 1914. Served at Gallipoli and Middle East. Suffered from sickness, including rheumatism. Returned to Australia 7 January 1919.
