Enlisted at Rockhampton, Qld, on 2 February 1916 aged 25 years 4 months.

Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs Henrietta Isabel Eva Long, Calliope via Gladstone, Qld. (Father Jeremiah Long).

On enlistment he was 6 feet 0.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 10 lbs. His chest measurement was 34 inches. His occupation was farmer. Served in Egypt and Middle East. In hospital 8 weeks with malaria with numerous recurrences. Also, arthritis in old fracture of humerus. Returned to Australia 17 July 1919.
