

Next-of-kin was John Faucett (sic Fawcett) Lyon, Cawarral, via Rockhampton, Qld. Mother Mary Maria Brenan. On enlistment he was 5 ft 8 inches and weighed 154 lbs. His chest measurement was 36-38 inches. His occupation was miner. Transferred from Light Horse Regiment 20 November 1915 at sea. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A48 *Seang Bee* on 21 October 1915. Disembarked Alexandria. Sick to hospital 15 May 1916. Transferred to France 28 August 1916. Wounded in action France 5 April 1917 GSW knee. Returned to field 1 June 1917. Numerous incidents of AWL. Returned to Australia 18 May 1915 per *Armagh.*
