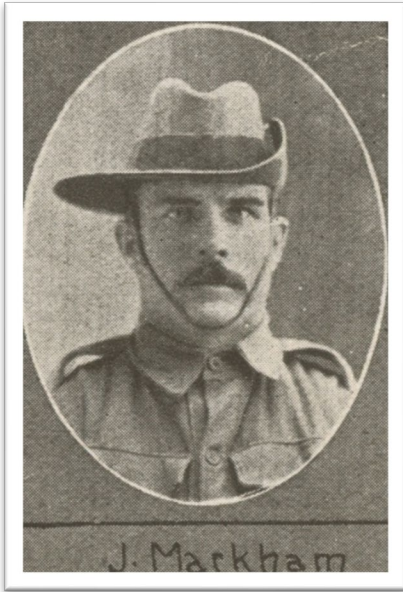


MARKHAM, Jeremiah

Unit: 25th Battalion/2nd Pioneer Battalion

Place of Birth: Victoria.

Date of Birth: c. 1878 (Vic BDM 1875 Reg 14350/1875)

Enlisted at Brisbane, on 10 June 1915 aged 37 years 11 months. (Age probably 40 years). Next-of-kin was mother Mrs 'Maynighan' (Believed to be Mrs Mary Monahan, Flemington, Victoria. Mary Markham married Michael Monahan, Victoria 1898 Reg 6615/1898)

On enlistment he was 5 feet 8.5 inches and weighed 170 lbs. His chest measurement was 39 inches. His occupation was miner. Served in France. Wounded in Action 5 August 1916. Rejoined battalion 25 August 1916. Sick with growth on neck, 27 May 1917. Sent to hospital UK. Overseas to France 2 March 1918. Sick with abscess on thigh 11 April 1918. Invalided to UK 23 April 1918. Overseas to France 5 August 1918. Returned to Australia 17 April 1919. Discharged 9 June 1919.
