On enlistment he was 5 feet 10 inches and weighed 12 Stone 4 lbs. His chest measurement was 38-42 inches. His occupation was police constable, Gladstone, Qld. Embarked from Brisbane on 17 November 1916. Served France. He was accidentally injured when his foot was caught between the wheel of limber (cart) and wheel of a gun carriage, by the recoil of the gun. Fractured base of 2nd metatarsal. Foot in splints for five (5) weeks. Invalided out due to recurrent pain in muscles of the calf of left leg. Returned to Australia 6 November 1918. Discharged 3 February 1919.
