Next-of-kin was sister, Maria Martin, 94 Pyrmont St, Pyrmont, Sydney, NSW then 125 Vera Street, Marrickville, NSW.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 9.5 inches and weighed 151 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-36 inches. His occupation was labourer. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board HMAT RMS *Orontes* on 10 November 1915. This unit disbanded after 250 days. Then, unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board RMS *Morea* on 17 February 1917. Served Moascar. Contracted malaria in Middle East. Returned to Australia 29 April 1916. Returned to Australia 28 January 1919.

Died: Michael Patrick McArdle died 25 May 1942. Parents Thomas McArdle, Mary (nee Harvey). Buried 26 May 1942, Winton Cemetery, Qld.
