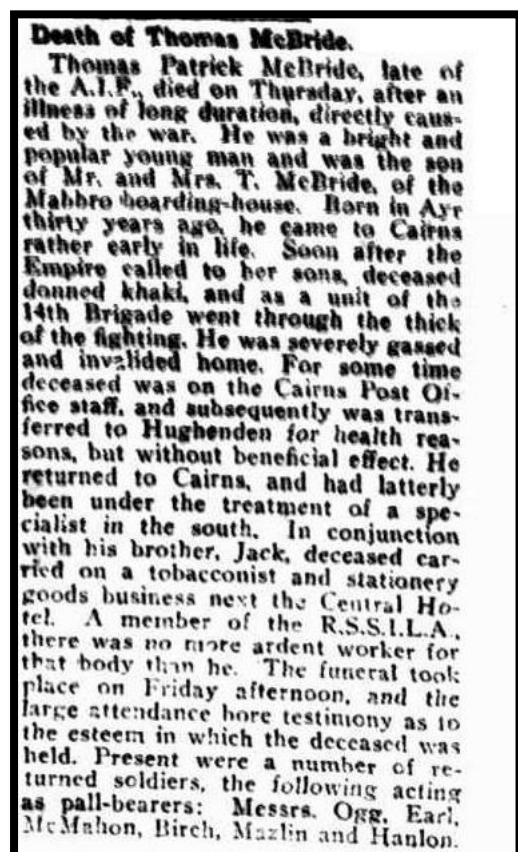


McBRIDE, Thomas Patrick

Date of Birth: 27 March 1890

Enlisted at Brisbane, Qld, on 10 June 1915 aged 24 years 3 months.

Next-of-kin was father, Mr T McBride, Sachs Street, Cairns, North Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 10.75 inches and weighed 10 stone 5 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-36 inches. His occupation was public servant, Post Office. Served Egypt, Gallipoli, and France. Transferred Army Postal Corps 21 December 1916. Suffered influenza, pleurisy and return of tuberculosis. Permanently unfit. Returned to Australia 16 December 1917. Discharged 3 April 1918.
