On enlistment he was 5 feet 4.25 inches and weighed 128 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-36 inches. His occupation was Authorised Surveyor. Served Gallipoli, Egypt, France. Returned to Australia 4 July 1919.

Medals: 28 December 1917 for distinguished and gallant services and devotion to duty in the field during the period 26 February and 21 September 1917 at the Hindenberg line.
