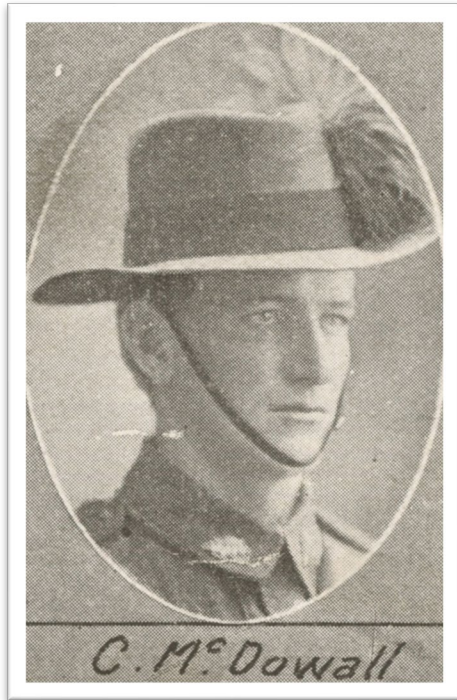


McDOUALL, Crichton

Unit: 2nd Light Horse Regiment, 11th Reinforcement/5th Divisional Ammunition Column.

Place of Birth: Singleton, New South Wales

Date of Birth: 1890

Enlisted at Brisbane, Qld, on 7 July 1915 aged 25 years 5 months.

Next-of-kin was father, Patrick James Crichton McDouall, Calliope Station, Gladstone, Queensland

On enlistment he was 5 feet 10 inches and weighed 142 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-37 inches. His occupation was grazier. (Partner to J Lockie Wilson in Calliope Station.) Embarked from Sydney on 4 October 1915. Served Egypt, then France. Returned to Australia per "Niagara" 11 August 1919. Died 14 January 1952.
