

McNAE, Andrew Murray

NB: No service record has been found in Australia (to date) for Andrew Murray McNAE. As he was born in Scotland, it is possible that he signed up with a Scottish regiment. This document contains details known about Andrew Murray McNAE.

Place of Birth: District of Maryhill, County of Lanark, Scotland

Date of Birth: 22 December 1887 at 12 noon, 11 Melonside Avenue, Maryhill, Scotland.

Family information known:

Father: Robert McNae, travelling draper.

Mother: Margaret McNae (maiden surname Murray)

Parents marriage: 13 December 1878, Minnigaff, Scotland.

Robert McNae and his family moved to Many Peaks, Queensland, Australia and Robert applied for a Victualler's Licence. This was granted on 13 April 1911. Another licensee took over in 1913.

Andrew Murray McNAE appears in the 1912, 1913 & 1914 Australian Electoral Commission Rolls for Capricornia Gladstone as a miner at Many Peaks.

He next appears in the 1915, 1916 & 1917 AEC Rolls for Wide Bay Eidsvold as a stockman at Langley Eidsvold.

No AEC Roll has been found for 1918.

The 1919 AEC Roll for Capricornia Gladstone has him back at Many Peaks employed as a stockman.
