On enlistment he was 5 feet 6.75 inches and weighed 8 stone 12 lbs. His chest measurement was 35 inches. His occupation was farmer/labourer in Mackay, Qld. Embarked from Sydney, NSW on 8 July 1916. Served Egypt. Wounded 19 April 1917. Taken to hospital. Returned to duty same day. To be Lance Corporal. Returned to Australia 2 August 1919. Discharged Died 27 May 1951.
