

## **MILLER, Charles Spiers (Speirs) (Chas on Honour Roll)**

Rank: Private

Service Number: 432

Unit: 42<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, B Company.

Place of Birth: Rockhampton, Qld

Date of Birth: 28 December 1894

Enlisted at Rockhampton, Queensland, on 19 October 1915 aged 20 years 11 months.

Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs Annie (Agnes) Miller, 'King's Rest', Raglan, Qld. Father Samuel Miller.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 9.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 2 lbs. His chest measurement was 37 inches. His occupation was labourer. Embarked 5 June 1916. Served France. Wounded in action GSW to back, 25 March 1917.

Rejoined unit 20 April 1917. Wounded in action (second time) 10 June 1917. Embarked for England. Admitted Eastbourne Military Hospital. SW to head, severe.) 15 June 1917. Proceeded France rejoin unit 30 September 1917.

Appointed Lance Corporal. Then appointed temporary corporal. Reverted to Lance Corporal. Discharge sought by family due to hardship. Granted. Returned to Australia 1 February 1918. Discharged 13 July 1918.
