Enlisted at Gladstone, Qld, on 19 August 1915, aged 26 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs Mary Percival, 10 Bedford Place, Rock Ferry, Cheshire, England.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 6 inches and weighed 120 lbs. His chest measurement was 32-35.5 inches. His occupation was cab driver. Served in France and Belgium. Married Ada Jane TRENT in Whitechapel, England, 20 October 1918. 20 January 1919 sprained ankle. Returned to Australia with wife 9 September 1919. Discharged 28 November 1919.
