Enlisted at Rockhampton, on 21 November 1916 aged 18 years 1 month.

Next-of-kin was father, J Moore, Beecher Station, Boyne Valley line, near Gladstone Queensland. (Mother Emma Jane Moore, nee Gent).

On enlistment he was 5 feet 9 inches and weighed 145 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-35 inches. His occupation was labourer. Unit embarked from Melbourne, Victoria, on board HMAT A71 *Nestor* on 21 November 1917. Served Egypt and France. Returned to Australia 23 July 1919. Discharged
